There were no deaths recorded on this copy of the manifest.

Passenger numbers have been added for ease in referencing.

- 28 Micael as found.
- 37 The name could have been something like Smiddy.
- 41-43 Spelled both Osagar and Osager.
- 50 Could not make out the missing letter.
- 58 Spelled as found, though next to a group named Keary.
- 72 Probably should have been O'Day.
- 74 Elen as found.
- 76 Sullivan sometimes spelled Sullivan.
- 87 Lwoley as found.
- 125 Spelled McCarty.

Notes from Ken Beirne (<http://www.Beirne.com>):

Of the 146 passengers, there are 11 Kellys (nos. 1-4, 17-22,36).

Our Kelly ancestors are nos. 20-22 (Michael, John & Daniel). This is confirmed by their citizenship papers filed in Sullivan County, PA on February 19, 1850. On those documents, they declared that they came together to America. Those papers also indicate 1846 as their arrival year which could have been an error. In any event, their ages are confirmed in several US census records so I conclude that these are our forbears.

We do not know if any of the other Kellys or passengers named in the passenger log were related.

Daniel is my great-grandfather.

The transatlantic crossing could take approximately 5-12 weeks at that time so they departed Cobh between February & March 1847.
